New Business: Safety modifications to the new engine were discussed. Getting the ladders out of their current storage area is almost impossible, getting them refitted so they are easier to access and store. Change will cost \$3,850 to fix. Tried to choose the most economical solution. Must transport engine back east, and also pay someone time to do the transfer. Will work to get this done after rally before winter. // 2021 Draft Budget discussed. Line items discussed. There is an increase of \$16,640 over the 2020 budget.
